

2021 Pennsylvania State USBC Tournament Operations

ALL mandates instituted by the state of Pennsylvania WILL be required and enforced. These include and are not limited to:

- **Everyone** (bowlers, tournament assistants, others) entering the bowling center are **required to wear a mask**.
- **Spectators/Guests** are limited to one per bowler. Please limit non bowlers in your group as much as possible to reduce overcrowding within the center.
- **Masks** are required at all times; in the bowler's area, when leaving the bowling area (restrooms, bar, etc.). Masks may be lowered when on the approach, delivering the ball, and will be immediately and properly replaced following the ball delivery. Masks may be lowered while actively drinking or eating but should be replaced when finished.
- **Team Captains** are responsible for the conduct of all teammates.
- **Check-In:** Team Captains or one team member will check in ALL team members at the Team center, social distancing to be observed.
- One or the other doubles partners will check in for both bowlers at the Doubles center, social distancing to be observed.
- Bowlers for both events should arrive at the center not more than 30 minutes ahead of scheduled bowling time. Social distancing to be observed. Incoming squads should remain socially distanced until your assigned lanes are cleaned and sanitized before moving in.
- When tournament bowling is completed, please vacate the bowling area immediately to allow time and space for sanitizing between squads.
- **Substitutions or Changes:** Team/Doubles with changes/substitutions should make said changes prior to arrival if possible. If an on-site change is necessary, you will be referred to the area/table for changes.
- **Raffles/Brackets:** Any raffles may be conducted by the host local association with social distancing observed and not in the bowler's area.
- Bracket monies will be picked up by one team member with all squad slips in his/her possession. Social distancing must be observed.

If any team member is not feeling well that bowler is NOT to enter the bowling center!

Failure to follow the mandates/rules as set forth by the State of Pennsylvania, bowling centers or Pennsylvania State USBC will result in expulsion from the bowling center, the tournament, forfeiture of entry fees and/or early termination of the tournament.
