Though Bruce Therminy is one of the top bowlers in the Bradford area, he entered into the Pennsylvania State USBC Hall of Fame for his meritorious service to the game of bowling.

Bruce has been a top administrator on the local, state and national levels. In the Bradford Bowling Association, he served as its President from 1978 to 1981. He also served as President of the Bradford Junior Bowling Association from 1966 to 1975. On the state level, Bruce served as a Western Area Director for five (5) years before being elected 4th Vice President in 1981, progressing through the chairs to become PSBA President for the 1985-1986 season. He has chaired many state committees, including the special 50th Anniversary Book Committee. He was instrumental in starting the tournament patch program. On the national level, Bruce was elected as an A.B.C. Director in 1985 and still serves in that capacity.

As a bowler, he has rolled two (2) 299 games and has twenty-two (22) 700 series, highest being 747. He finished 8th in the 1969 ABC tournament with an All Event total of 1944. His Zippo team finished in 11th place in the 1966 ABC tournament. He has many Bradford Association Championships. He has bowled in the PSBA tournaments and 19 ABC tournaments.
