Donald J. Smith entered the Pennsylvania State USBC Hall of Fame for his outstanding achievements in bowling.

Don has thirty-four sanctioned 300 games, eight 800 series, and over five hundred 700 series. His highest league average is 233. He has been active in organized bowling for 45 years.

He has bowled in 21 PSBC Tournament and 36 ABC/USBC National Tournaments. Don has four scratch PSBA Senior Titles, and his highest finish at the ABC/USBC Tournament was 4th in the singles event in Jacksonville FL with a 741 series. He finished 30th in Singles in 1977 in Reno NV and his team finished 31st in 1999 at Syracuse NY. Don was a member of the team that finished 6th out of 86 teams from 11 states that participated in the World Team Challenge regional.

In the York Adams Association, Don has five Scratch Team titles, three Scratch Doubles titles, one Scratch Singles title, and three Scratch All Events titles. He was inducted into the York Adams Association Hall of Fame in 1998.

Don also holds titles in the Eastern Senior Tournament Association, the North East Senior Association, the Buddy Tierno Senior Club, and the Tony Walton Tournament in Maryland.
