DR DEAN WOLF YEAR INDUCTED: 2012 CATEGORY: BOWLING ABILITY READING, PENNSYLVANIA

Dr. Dean Wolf entered the Pennsylvania State USBC, for his outstanding bowling ability.

Dean has ninety-nine 300s, sixty-two 800s, and over one thousand 700 series during his 30 years in organized bowling. His highest average was 244.

He bowled in 21 PSBA tournaments and 22 ABC/USBC tournaments. Dean was a member of the PSBA Team Champions in 1993, 1994, 1995, 1999, and 2008. In 2009 he and PSBA Hall of Fame member Steve Gehringer were the PSBA Doubles Champions. In 1992 Dean was a member of the team that won the ABC Championship. In the 1995 ABC tournament he placed second in the Doubles event, third in the Team All Events and finished eighth in the Individual All Events.

In the Reading Bowling Association, Dean holds seven team titles, four doubles titles and was the All Events champion twice. He was named to the All-Star Team seventeen times and was inducted into the Reading Bowling Association hall of Fame in 2008.

Dean has eight Dutchman Tournament titles, three Hoinke Tournament titles, and 17 other championships from around the country.
