Ed Szygiel entered the Pennsylvania State USBC, for his outstanding bowling ability.

Ed has been involved in organized bowling for over 40 years. He has bowled in twenty-five PSBA Championship tournaments and twenty-one ABC/USBC Tournaments. He has fifty-five 300 games, twenty-one 800 series, and over seven hundred 700 series to his credit. One of the 300 games he bowled was at the ABC Tournament in Knoxville, TN. His highest league average was 236 and his highest series is 868.

Ed holds the following PSBA achievements: Scratch Team Champion in 1998 and 2010. He bowled an 800 series in Lancaster and a 300 game in Erie. His team finished 2nd place two times and 3rd place 3 times in the PSBA Scratch Division. He and his partner finished 2nd twice in Doubles. He also was a member of the 2012 PSBA Senior Scratch Team Champions.

In the Bucks County USBC Association Ed holds eleven scratch titles. In the Mercer Burlington USBC Association of New Jersey, Ed has five titles and was Bowler of the Year three times. He is a Hall of Fame member of the Bucks County Association and the Mercer Burlington Association.

While in college Ed was named to the Eastern Pennsylvania and Maryland Intercollegiate Bowling Conference All Stars three years. From his college years to the present, Ed has amazed over sixty tournament titles in Pennsylvania and New Jersey. He has six Dutchman Tournament titles, four Hanover Tournament titles, and eight Buddy Tierno Tournament titles, to name a few.
