H. John Longacre III enters the Pennsylvania State USBC, for his outstanding bowling ability.

John has been involved in organized bowling for over 36 years. He has bowled in twenty-five PSBA Championship Tournaments and twenty-one ABC/USBC Tournaments. He has fifty 300 games, thirty-two 800 series, and over six hundred 700 series to his credit. His highest league average was 240 for 90 games.

John has amazed seventy-five tournament titles in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware, and Maryland. These include eight State titles, sixteen Association titles, and five Dutchman Tournament titles. While bowling in the PSBA Tournaments, John bowled two 300 games, one in Pittsburgh and one in Lancaster. He has bowled honor scores in twenty-seven different bowling centers. He has an ABC/USBC lifetime tournament average of 205 for 21 years.

John also has a fifth-place finish at a PBA Regional event and cashed in the 1993 United States Open, finishing in the top 24. He is the current or former holder of 27 State, Local Association, Tournament, and/or House records.
