Mike Carocchia entered the Pennsylvania State USBC Hall of Fame for his contributions to the game of bowling. Although Mike is well known for his work as an Association Secretary and as a PSBA Western Area Director, he is being inducted for his outstanding bowling achievements.

Mike has two (2) sanctioned 300 games, two (2) 299 games, 35 - 700 series with a high series of 790. In 1960, he became a member of the Top Team in the Pittsburgh area. In 1961, he was a member of that team for one of the nation's top performances with a score of 3375. In 1963, he was the Greater Pittsburgh Bowling Association City Tournament Doubles Champion. Also, in 1962, he was a member of Team Scratch Champions of the PSBA Tournament in Hazleton. In 1964, he was the first bowler to bowl a 300 in the Bowling Proprietors of Pittsburgh \$10,000.00 jackpot. He was a member of the 1973 Team Scratch Champions of the PSBA tournament. He has many other titles too numerous to mention. He has served the Greater Pittsburgh TenPin Association as its Secretary since 1990 and has been a PSBA Western Area Director since 1994.
