Paul Alig enters the Pennsylvania State USBC, for his outstanding bowling ability.

Paul has been involved in organized bowling for over 39 years. He has bowled in twenty-three PSBA Championship Tournaments and twenty-three ABC/USBC Tournaments. He has fifty-one 300 games, forty-two 800 series, and over two hundred 700 series to his credit.

His highest league average is 237 and his highest series is 857.

Paul was a member of the team that won PSBA Scratch Team Championship in 1998 and 2010. He and his partner finished 2^{nd} twice in Doubles. He won Championships or been part of Championship Teams in the New Jersey State tournament, Bucks County USBC, Southeast USBC, and the Allentown District USBC. His team finished in the top 12 three times at the National Tournament with a best finish of 4^{th} place in 2010.

While in college Paul won over sixteen team, doubles, and singles titles and was named to the Eastern Pennsylvania and Maryland Intercollegiate Bowling Conference All Stars three times. His team made it to the Collegiate National Team finals three years.

Paul has amazed over sixty tournament titles. He has six Dutchman Tournament titles, four Hanover Tournament titles, and five Buddy Tierno Tournament titles, to name a few.
