Robert H. Ellis enters the Pennsylvania State USBC Hall of Fame for his meritorious service to the game of bowling.

Bob served as the Assistant Secretary Treasurer of the Pottstown Bowling Association. He also served as the Secretary Treasurer of two leagues, one over twenty years and the other over thirty years. You could find Bob at many bowling functions in the Reading Pottstown area speaking on the benefits of being a sanction bowler and encouraging state tournament participation.

On the state level Bob has attended the PSBA Conventions since the late 1960's, missing only one due to an illness. Bob served as a PSBA Eastern Area Director for fifteen years before becoming an Advisory Board life member. Over the years he has served on almost every PSBA committee. For over twenty-five years Bob has served on the PSBA Registration Committee, putting in countless hours of work at the PSBA Conventions.

He has been the Chairman of this committee for over fifteen years.

Bob has bowled in 45 PSBA Tournaments, 10 PSBA Senior Tournaments, and 22 ABC/USBC National Tournaments. His highest average is 195. Bob was inducted into the Pottstown Hall of Fame in 1978 and is a member of the Pennsylvania American Legion Sports Hall of Fame. He is retired from the Occidental Chemical Co.
